In 2003, the Southeast Glass Association (SEGA) was successful in working with the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB) in developing a statewide voluntary license for glass and glazing specialty contractors. The first exam was given in October 2003. The SEGA Board of Directors met in August 2006 and discussed the possibility of making the voluntary glass and glazing license mandatory during the 2007 Legislative Session. Currently, no proposed legislative language has been introduced as this is only a concept at the present time.
